



## Pro series 2023 rules and entry

### **General Rules:**

- \* The Promoters are the **Central Vic Lure Casters Incorporated**
- \* All registered fish must be caught on a lure. No fresh baits or live baits are permitted to be used in this competition
- \* In the case of a tie the earliest registered fish will be determined the winner.
- \* It is the responsibility of entrants to be fully aware of regulations covering minimum sizes and bag limits of fish, the requirements of appropriate boat licenses and safety equipment for NSW and VIC waters.
- \* Any boat found to be in the possession of illegal fishing equipment will be disqualified from the competition
- \* The promoter at any time may refuse or reject any registrations to any day of the event
- \* All persons in a boat actively fishing during the competition must be registered anglers
- \* The promoter's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- \* All Anglers must adhere to the relevant states fishing and boating rules and regulations.
- \* All anglers must have a current fishing license relevant to the State in which they are fishing
- \* Any Angler found to be in breach of any of the rules set out above may be disqualified immediately
- \* Anglers cannot fish within 30m (Casting Distance) from another competitor unless invited in to do so.
- \* There will be no tying up to tress in this event
- \* Live scope is allowed in this event

### **Proof of Catch:**

- \* We require two photos of your catch.  
Photo one- Must be on your brag mat with supplied catch token,  
Photo two- A photo of you holding your catch.
- \* Digital photographs are to be produced to allocated phone number at the event
- \* If the photo is displayed incorrectly on the brag matt that FISH WILL NOT COUNT
- \* As the photo has been sent, we require the team's name and angler attached in the message
- \* A returned text message will be sent to you with a confirmed length of your catch as fast as possible

### **Scoring:**

- \* Scores of your 5 best Murray Cod per day will determine a team's points (Upgrades allowed)
- \* Murray Cod = 60cm equals 60 points
- \* Murray Cod are catch and release only in this event
- \* Golden Perch are classed as a by catch and receive 10 points up to 50 points
- \* All scores will be erased at the end of each day with all teams starting at 0 points each morning

All fishing is to be seized at the finish time. We will accept photos 5 minutes after finish time e.g. 5.05pm
